

# Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest

1. To obtain maximum participation the contest MUST be Council driven
2. Council shall order the CCEC Kit # 4202
3. Guide and resource book #4202-EA  
Entry form/Judging sheet #4208  
Participation certificates #4206  
Winners' certificates #4207  
Other resources as needed
4. Council representatives shall contact local schools to make them aware of the contest and invite their students' participation
5. Contest is open to students in grades eight (8) to twelve (12)
6. Schools are asked to submit one winner for each grade level
7. Councils will submit the best entry for each grade to the DISTRICT DEPUTY
8. District Deputy (or team) will submit the District's winner to Ontario State
9. State Team will appraise and select FIRST and SECOND place in each grade
10. State Team will award prizes and submit First place essays to Supreme.

Please be aware that, in addition to GKs and DDs, School Boards were notified directly last year therefore the staff should already be aware of the CCEC and the parameters.

This year INCOMPLETE/LATE/NON-GUIDELINES entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

- A) Essays must reflect the assigned theme (to be announced in the next couple of weeks)
- B) Essays must be the student's original work
- C) Essays must be typed and limited to 500-750 words in length
- D) The student's name will be typed and appear only on the CCEC Entry form and stapled to the essay.**
- E) All entries become the property of the KofC and will not be returned.

**Timelines:**

September: Students write essays and submit school winners to councils.

October: Judges review essays for council and District level

November 15: Essays submitted to State for Jurisdiction evaluation and submission to Supreme.
