

- Started with 19 vendor Councils, currently 39 Councils are actively selling (70% engagement)
 - Sales (as of March 27) \$ 42,550
 - Jackpot: \$21,275

 - Top sellers: Orillia 1428 \$ 3,580





1. Do Links Work With All Browsers?

 The Technical Solution Provider (Ascend) recommends Chrome, Edge, NOT Internet Explorer

2. What are the Rules of Play?

- They are displayed in the Knights 5050 landing page, in both English and French
- The Rules are approved by the AGCO

3. What Support Is Available for Councils selling tickets?

4. What Support Is Available for Buyers from the Public?

5. What to do if a Buyer changes his/her mind after buying?

- Contact State Office at 1-800-759-0959.
- The ticket (s) will need to be Void and a Refund processed. This
 requires special Administrator tools only available to State
 Office.

6. What if the Buyer did not get an email confirmation?

- Contact State Office at 1-800-759-0959.
- Ask Buyer to check the Junk folder
- The email can be re-sent. If the email address is incorrect, an Alternate email address must be provided

- 7. How can a Council know their sales?
 - Contact Liane at the State Office at 1-800-759-0959.
 - For Pilot # 2 you could also call Jaime Libaque at (416) 456 7084

- 8. What can be done for buyers without Credit Cards?
 - A friend or relative can offer to make the payment

9. Can a non-resident from Ontario buy tickets?

The AGCO rules require proof of residence for winners

10. What is the expected return on sales for Councils?

- We hope that the 50-50 raffle will permit councils share percentage (%) to be equal or a higher percentage share than the previous paper lottery (lower 50/50 costs compared to paper lottery)
- After Pilot # 1 is done we will know better. The State Board will make a decision on the payout.

11. How can Councils promote the 50/50 given the COVID restrictions? Here are some ideas:

- Encourage their members with cell phones, laptops or tablets to
 place the landing page in their favorites, From there encourage each
 member to post the event on their Facebook, Twitter, Instagram
 accounts on a regular basis during the draw.
- Next, assign someone from the Council or a wife or son who has the knowledge of using social media, to reach out to other organizations supported by the Knights of Columbus locally, for example Soup Kitchen, Salvation Army, Red Cross, etc. We could provide them with an introductory page to present to these organizations asking them to promote the program either internally, or on their website or on individual social media pages as it can only benefit local charities.

11. How can Councils promote the 50/50 given the COVID restrictions? (...continued)

- Appoint one or two individuals, who are good Public Speakers and writers, to call all sources of media available to see if they would be so kind as to promote the 50-50.
- From there, letters would have to be written both for
 - online media; and
 - be prepared to mail a hard copy for those that need it




