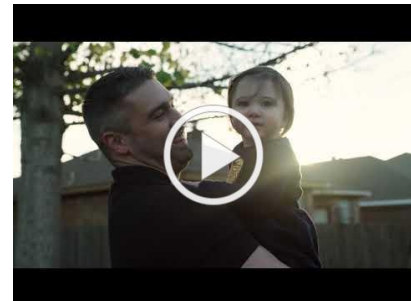
Membership Growth

Continue to Promote MCGIVNEY2020

Prospects are able to join the Order online free of charge until June 30. Please continue to promote this in your parish bulletin and through other communication tools at your disposal. Don't forget about the 20,000 men who have joined the Order online this fraternal year. Work with your district deputy to identify who they are and bring them into your council through an [in-person or virtual](#) Exemplification of Charity, Unity & Fraternity.

Be Active and Visible on Social Media

It is critical to be in touch with brother Knights and prospects. Utilize your council social media accounts to promote the Knights of Columbus and membership in your council. District Deputy Corner

- Remind your councils of the revised [Star Council requirements](#) and encourage them to finish the year strong and earn this award by utilizing the [Remote Programming Supplement](#), [Online Exemplification](#) and Fraternal Benefits Seminar [double credit incentive](#).
- Plan to hold the Installation of Council Officers as close to the start of the new fraternal year as practical. Guidelines for in-person and virtual installations can be found [here](#).
- Review your progress toward earning [Star District](#). Remember that new this year are the requirements that each council in the district earn the [Founder's Award](#) and two [Semiannual Report on Council Status](#) (#944) forms are submitted for each council.

Council Officer Corner

Grand Knight

- Ensure timely processing of your [RSVP](#) and [Food for Families](#) refund applications by gathering the necessary supporting documentation and submitting the forms early.
- Continue to work with your pastor and district deputy on the [COVID Recovery Plan](#) for your council and parish community.
- If local authorities permit, consider holding an in-person [Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity](#) before the end of the fraternal year. This is a great way to bring the community together and add new members to your council.

Financial Secretary

- If your council's annual accounting period ends Dec. 31, then May 15 was the deadline to submit the proper [IRS form 990](#) (US Councils only). Ensure that this paperwork was filed.
- Immediately after council elections the *Report of Officers Chosen for the Term* (#185) and *Service Program Personnel Report* (#365) should be submitted via the Member Management portal of [Officers Online](#). This method immediately updates the Supreme Council system at the start of the new fraternal year with the name and contact information for all officers and directors of your council.
