 - Major Programs will have a Chairman




Top Three Priorities

New Meeting Guidelines

- Changes to Meeting Protocol
- Method of Conducting Council Meetings 10318
- Opening and Closing Ode are eliminated.
- Where the guidelines say "pledge of allegiance" Canadian Councils substitute national anthem.
- Meetings should conclude in under an hour
- Non-Knights and family members may attend as long as GK obtains member approval.
- Only council members may conduct business and vote



Public Relations

- Encourage Councils to publicize their good works.
- Excellent Resources in Officer's Desk Reference
- Local newspapers are always looking for well-written stories and pictures.
- Ontario State Website & Bulletin, Columbia Magazine, and Knights in Action
- Media Inquiries handled by State Deputy unless scope is larger in which case handled by Supreme.
 - Never speculate on an issue, even if trying to be helpful!
