Order Delta Drive Kits (free to all councils)

Order drives from Knights of Columbus Office either (GK or FS)

Order Catalogs from (W)D-G-K Free Supplies On-Line

Schedule Information Night and Exemplification within 2 weeks of drive.

Develop Ambassadors

- 2-3 weeks prior to drive date.

Build Ambassador Teams and agree on roles.

Confirm Public Speaker

Submit Press Event Bulletin Announcement

Send "Welcome You Home" Poster

Day of Event

Arrive early and assign Ambassadors to locations.

Assign roles

Remind Ambassadors to enter information from cards into the Prospect Landing Page after each mass and not to give out the URL of the Prospect Landing Page.

Clean up church afterwards to ensure nothing is left in the pews.

Reminder – All council supplies, including program, candidate, and Church drive kits, must be ordered by the Grand Knight or Financial Secretary from [Supplies Online](#) via [Officers Online](#). Supply orders are not accepted at the Supreme Council.

Men join active councils, so if your council is struggling to find your footing coming out of COVID, the Order's [COVID Recovery Plan](#) (CRP) can serve to increase overall activity and attract new members. The CRP is a straightforward, field-tested way to re-engage the members of your council.

District Deputies – Are You On-Track?

The goal for the first quarter of the fraternal year (July 1 – September 30) is 30% or more of your annual district intake goal. Each state council has a goal of one Exemplification of Charity, Unity & Fraternity per district per quarter. Are you on-track to meet those goals? - Review the Safe Environment Member Status Report on the Reports Tab of [Officers Online](#). Make sure all required positions are filled and the members will remain compliant through the end of the fraternal year. Members must take refresher training every three years. - Review the [Public Relations and Publicity Guide](#) (#2235) for tips on promoting the good works of your council and attracting new members. This is a great way to expand the impact your council can have in the parish and community.
- Build a strong leadership bench by identifying future leaders of your council, empowering them to run initiatives, and mentoring them on [fraternal operations](#).
