
Our Goal: A Council in Every Parish

Worthy District Deputies,

Each District in Ontario is unique, so your position as a DD won't be the same as each of you will have to deal with issues that other District's may not have.

As a DD only you are aware of the dynamics of your District and whether there are parishes that do not currently have an active Council.

We are reaching the Half-year mark of this Fraternal year, and I urge you to assist me in fulfilling Fr. Michael McGivney's goal of an active Council in every parish, and to be able to reach our Jurisdiction's quote of 9 new Councils.

Let us review together how this can be achieved.



7 steps to starting a Council

Step 1: Approach your Pastor to discuss the benefits of starting a K of C Council.

- Step 2: Parish Bulletin AnnouncementAcquire promotional material from State OfficeAsk parish priest for list of potential candidates
- **Step 3:** Parish Membership Drive/Pulpit Announcements Church display/information table
- Step 4: 1st Information Meeting with candidates and families Invite Field Agent Personal Testimony Fill out Form 100 (candidates) Fill out form 133 (Notice of Intent) with State Deputy signature and submit to Supreme



7 steps (continued)

Step 5: 2'nd Information Meeting

Contact and invite potential candidates/friends/relatives/families Hold an Exemplification (don't wait for 20 candidates) Discuss the election process and appointed positions in a Council Discuss potential Council name

Step 6: 3rd Information meeting

Hold Exemplification for remaining candidates Complete Form 136 (Application for Charter Council) and submit to State Deputy and Supreme



Step 7: Upon receiving a Council number from Supreme, hold Council elections, plan Installation of Officers, and 1st business meeting.

Complete and submit Form 137 (Application for Charter) within 90 days of receiving the new council number.



Now that you have formed a new Council you are entitled to pick **2** incentives from the New Council Incentive package. You may share the incentive with the parish priest or another member who assisted you in establishing the new Council.
