## Eucharistic Revival

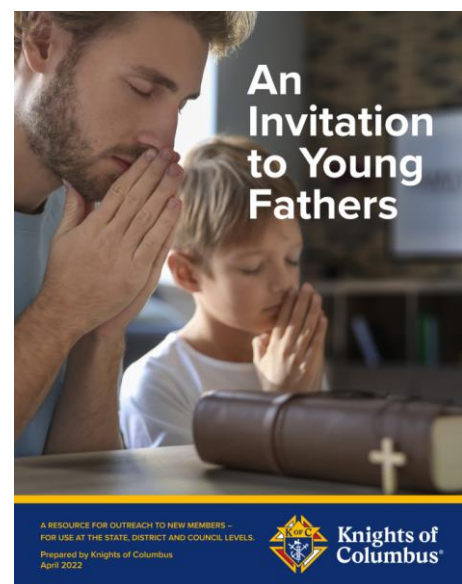
Countless dioceses in the United States will celebrate the launch of the USCCB's [National Eucharistic Revival](#) by hosting Eucharistic Processions on the upcoming Feast of Corpus Christi (Sunday, June 19, 2022)! The Supreme Knight has asked all Knights to stand ready to assist their pastors and bishops in conducting them on that day and throughout the Fraternal Year. Please reach out to your pastor to see how you can help.

New Eucharistic Procession resources are available at [kofc.org/eucharist](https://kofc.org/eucharist) for councils to assist in their planning and implementation. They can also be ordered on Supplies Online under the Holy Hour program category. In addition, Eucharistic Processions now fall under the Holy Hour program ([kofc.org/holyhour](https://kofc.org/holyhour)), a Featured Program. Hosting 2 Holy Hours and 1 Eucharistic Procession during the fraternal year will earn a council two program credits. ## Check Your Safe Environment Compliance Today!

- Fraternal Year End is quickly approaching – Be sure that your council is eligible to receive fraternal awards by ensuring that they are compliant with the Order’s safe environment program. You may review the safe environment compliance status of your council(s) on reports available through Officers’ Online. Work with members holding Grand Knight, Program, Family, and Community Director roles, as well as Columbian Squires Counselors, to complete their assigned safe environment training and background checks ASAP. Completed safe environment training and background checks are valid for three (3) years. For more information, click this link to the [Knights of Columbus State Leader Compliance Guide](#).

## Grand Knight

- [Submit the Columbian Award Application](#) (#SP-7) as soon as your council has completed [16 program activities or credits](#).
- Continue to submit [Fraternal Program Report Form](#) (#10784) for program activity upon completion of every event. This report gives us important real time data on council activities. Your inputs are used in ongoing evaluation and improvements to our Faith in Action programs.
- Schedule a transition meeting with outgoing and incoming officers and directors.
- Work with your District Deputy to schedule the [Installation of Council Officers](#).

## Financial Secretary

- Timely processing of member additions and changes is critical as we approach the end of the fraternal year. If your council is on track to earn Star Council, all form 100s need to be processed by June 30. The quickest and easiest way to process form 100s is via the [Candidate Tab on Officers Online](#).
