Coats for kids

- **7188** new kids winter coats were distributed across Ontario in 2022
- Our goal for 2023: **10,000** coats
- Cost: \$335/box (includes taxes and S & H charges)
- 12 mixed styles and sizes per box
- Each box consists of either all Boys or all Girls (no mixed)
- Coats are available for delivery now
- Purchases or cash donations can be made online
- Credit card payments are accepted
- Individuals who purchase a box or make a cash donation(min. \$20) will be issued a charitable tax receipt.



Basketball Free Throw Championship

- ▶ Available to boys and girls aged 9 to 17 years old and 15 to 17 years old within Ontario only.
- ▶ Over 37, 500 children participated in 2019-2020.
- ▶ Competition Dates – Should be completed by:
 - ▶ Council: January 31st, 2023
 - ▶ District: February 19th, 2023
 - ▶ Regional: March 12th, 2023



Basketball Free Throw Championship

- ▶ Information package and all forms will be available on the State Website in English and French in late August.

- ▶ All kits & district medals must be ordered through Supplies Online which can be accessed in the Officers Portal. Please have your GKs or FSs order the kits in July to be ready for the start of school in September.
- ▶ DDs should order your district medals in July. Currently you will need to order a set and you will need your council to order the 2nd set if you need more than 12 medals.
- ▶ Webbmason runs out of both kits and district medals in November & again in January. ORDER THEM NOW!!!



Basketball Free Throw Championship

- ▶ Newest mandate by Insurance Companies in 2021 requires all members volunteering at a youth event **MUST** have a current police background check on file with the Council's GK.
- ▶ Above also applies to DDs and Regional Chairmen when convening District and Regional competitions.

Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest

- To obtain maximum participation the contest MUST be Council driven
- Council shall order:
 - the CCEC Kit # 4202
 - Guide and resource book #4202EA
 - Entry form/Judging sheet #4208
 - Participation certificates #4206
 - Winners' certificates #4207
 - Other resources as needed
- Council representatives shall contact local schools to make them aware of the contest and invite their students' participation
- Contest is open to students in grades eight (8) to twelve (12)
- Schools are asked to submit one winner for each grade level



Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest

- Councils will submit the best entry for each grade to the DISTRICT DEPUTY
- District Deputy (or team) will submit the District's winner to Ontario State
- State Team will appraise and select FIRST and SECOND place in each grade
- State Team will award prizes and submit First place essays to Supreme.

Please be aware that, in addition to GKs and DDs, School Boards were notified directly last year therefore the staff should already be aware of the CCEC and the parameters. This year INCOMPLETE / LATE entries WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.



Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest

- Essays must reflect the assigned theme (to be announced in the next couple of weeks)
- Essays must be the student's original work
- Essays must be typed and limited to 500-750 words in length
- The student's name will be **typed and appear only on the CCEC Entry form** and stapled to the essay.
- All entries become the property of the KofC and will not be returned.

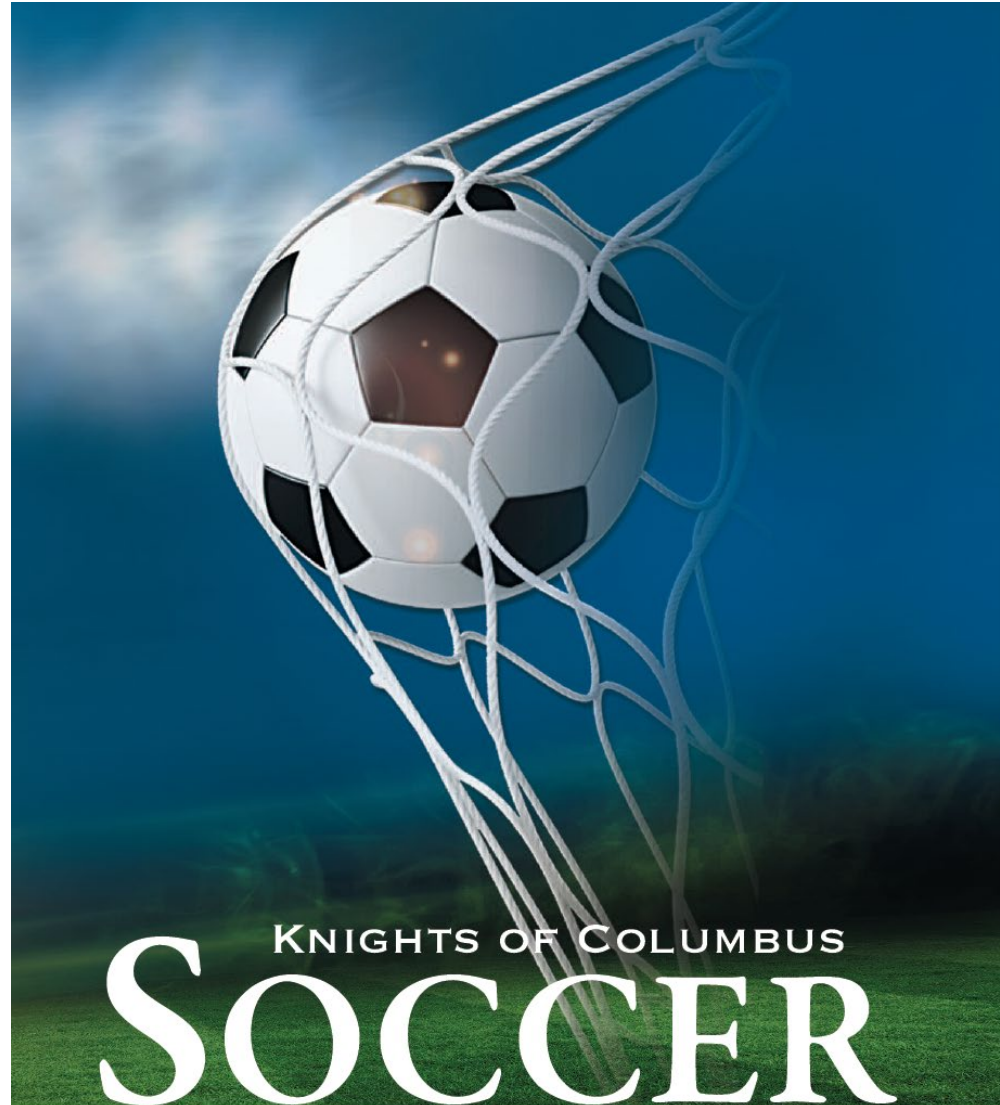
Timelines:

September: Students write essays and submit school winners to councils.

October: Judges review essays for council and District level.

November 15: Essays submitted to State for Jurisdiction evaluation and submission to Supreme.
