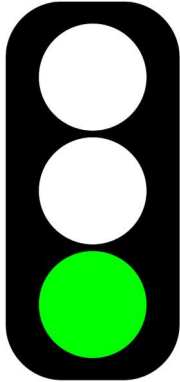

## **GREEN: LOW RISK** – “VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS” OR MINORS NOT PRESENT

**Requirements:** None

Examples Of Low-Risk Activities Include:

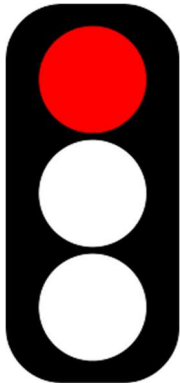
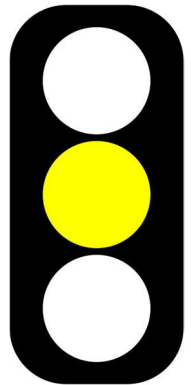
- 1) Business Meetings
- 2) Council Social Nights and Events Involving Only Members & Spouses
- 3) Council Fundraising Events Involving Only Members & Spouses
- 4) Golf Tournaments

## **YELLOW: MEDIUM RISK** – “VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS” OR MINORS MAY BE PRESENT BUT UNDER SUPERVISION BY 3<sup>rd</sup> PARTY

**Requirements:** All Members Participating Must Read & Acknowledge Abuse Protocol Annually

Examples Of Medium-Risk Activities Include:

- 1) Parish Events Such as Pancake Breakfasts or Spaghetti Dinners
- 2) Life Chain / Pro-Life Demonstrations or Events
- 3) Food Served to Members of the Public



## **RED: HIGH RISK** – “VULNERABLE INDIVIDUALS” OR MINORS UNDER DIRECT SUPERVISION OF MEMBERS

**Requirements:** All Members Participating Must Read & Acknowledge Abuse Protocol Annually  
& All Members Participating Must Also Provide Clean Police Check (Within 5 Years)

Examples Of High-Risk Activities Include:

- 1) Youth Basketball Free Throw Competitions, Soccer Challenges, Hockey (Target) Shooting Challenges
- 2) Squire Events & Activities
- 3) Supporting A High School Student with Volunteer Hours
- 4) School Breakfast Programs & BBQ Lunches
- 5) Direct Support for Elderly, Vulnerable or Widowed i.e., Volunteering at a Care Home
